Release Notes

GS1 Canada is continually enhancing New ProSYNC based on community business requirements, Global Standards Alignment and feedback from our users.

This document shows a summary.

- Help Resource Library
When you click the Help Resources link, a panel appears with links to user support documents, videos and other help resources.
- Prefix Validation Warning
Every time you enter a GTIN, the system performs a validation check to ensure integrity of that GTIN. If you enter a GTIN that you are not authorized to use, a warning message appears. This validation does not stop the flow of data to your trading partners. If you have authorization from the GTIN owner, you can quickly move forward by providing the authorization to GS1 Canada. If you have made a keying error, you can fix the GTIN manually.
- Approval Status in the Status Panel
Compliant – not Approved and *Compliant – Approved* status levels appear on the Home page in the Status panel. With this enhancement, you can quickly identify GTINs that require action.
- Revisions to Search
These revisions will be seen by subscribers using New ProSYNC to load product manually:
 - Approval Status in Search Results
A GTIN can be compliant – indicating that it is ready to be shared with trading partners – and unless it is approved, data does not flow to your trading partners. With this release, approval status appears in the search results.
 - Revised Search Layout
We have moved two search criteria fields from Advanced to the Basic Search form to make it easier to search.

If you use ECCnet Classification Code to identify products, we have moved this search criterium to the Basic Search form.

Similarly, if you use Product Availability to identify product status, we have moved this field to the Basic Search form.
