Release Notes

GS1 Canada is continually enhancing ProSYNC based on community business requirements, global standards alignment and feedback from our users.

This release introduces the following improvements:

- For GDSN data providers selling into Canada, code value mapping for 'Nutrient Claim Type Code' and 'Nutrients' has been updated. This enables publishing of products to GS1 Canada.
- For GDSN data providers selling outside of Canada, mapping for 'Brand Owner GLN' and 'Brand Owner Name' was added. This is an alignment that enables publishing of products to 1WS.
- For organic grocery products, a constraining validation for Organic Certification Body and Certification Number has been removed, making data move more easily.
- In the Trading Partner Publication Report, column headers have been made more descriptive, allowing for more accurate data input.
