

Product Recall – Healthcare Checklist



Product Recall – Healthcare is a product recall communication service that shares real-time notifications, helping to remove harmful products sooner.

Just follow the simple steps below to register for Product Recall and get the valuable Recall Ready certification status. Being Recall Ready means your organization is prepared to act in the event of a recall.

1 Subscribe to Product Recall – Healthcare

Identify who will be your organization's Subscription Administrator. Have them log on to myGS1 and [subscribe to Product Recall – Healthcare](#).

They will receive an email to accept the End User License Agreement (EULA) and confirm the account.

2 Register Your Users

Manufacturers using Product Recall – Healthcare will need to register two or more users:

- a) an initiator, who launches new recall notifications
- b) an approver, who reviews notifications for accuracy

3 Complete a Mock Recall

To get Recall Ready, you must annually issue a mock recall using GS1 Canada's Product Recall service.
